His professional and research interests include behavior functioning in pathological states of the brain, rehabilitation of neurologically impaired patients, and neuropsychology of gerontology. Dr. Brinkman has written numerous articles on these topics over the years. He has served as a member of the Board of Directors for the Abilene-North Central Texas Chapter for Alzheimer's disease and Related Disorders Association and as chairman of the Board of Directors of the Big Country Chapter of the Texas Head Injury Foundation. Dr. Brinkman is married and has three children.
