BILL GUIDERA

Associate Vice President for Programs and Partnerships at TSTC

Bill Guidera of Texas State Technical College in Abilene will be our speaker for our noon meeting May 2, 2007, as we honor the Career and Technology Students of AISD. Bill has been with Texas State Technical College West Texas since 1999 serving as a member of the Faculty, then as Director of Institution Research, Associate Dean of Instruction at Sweetwater, and currently Associate Vice President concentrating on Program Development and Partnerships.

His leadership in partnerships has included Abilene Christian University and Genesis Networks; Western Texas College Dual Enrollment partnership; Florida Power and Light Energy Wind Energy partnership; Ranger College, Western Texas College and TSTC Associate Degree Nursing partnership.

Bill earned a BBA in Management and a minor in accounting from Corpus Christi State University. He also holds a Masters of Education majoring in Counseling and Human Development from Hardin Simmons University.

Previous to his TSTC responsibilities, Bill served our country with distinguished service as a Law Enforcement Specialist in the United States Air Force from 1977 through his retirement in 1984 while stationed at Bergstrom Air Force Base, Austin. His background also includes serving as a Federal Bank Examiner with the FDIC; Director of The Bair Foundation, Abilene. Ordained as a minister, Bill served on staff at Broadview Baptist Church here in Abilene, as Minister of Education and Counseling. He is married to Denise for 28 years and they have one child, Nich, who is now married and living in Abilene as well. Bill and Denise are both active in Emmaus wherein he serves on both the Big Country Community Board of Directors, and the Chrysalis Community Board of Directors.

Bill served on the steering committee that established the Child Advocacy center in Abilene. He has been named Staff member of the Year by the Abilene Baptist Association, named three times as Who's Who Among American College Teachers, and received the distinguished TSTC Chancellors Award for Excellence.

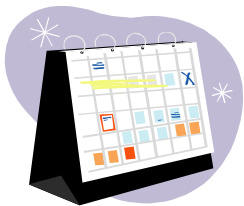
