Lynn Barnett has served as the Executive Director of the Abilene Cultural Affairs Council since 1980. She is responsible for working with Council committees as well as art organizations and city entities to enhance the quality of life in Abilene. She received her bachelor's degree in Psychology from Smith College in North Hampton, Mass., and her Master's degree in Management and Human Relations from Abilene Christian University.

Prior to coming to Abilene she served as Grants Program Associate for the Texas Commission on the Arts as well as the Director of the Artist in Residence Program for the State of Texas.

Lynn has served as a panelist for the National Endowment for the Arts and the Texas Commission on the Arts. She has also served as a site evaluator for the NEA and on the boards of the Texas Assembly and Arts Councils, Texas Sculpture Symposium, and Texas Accountants and Lawyers for the Arts.

She currently serves on the boards of Frontier Texas, the National Center for Children's Illustrated Literature, and as President of the statewide arts advocacy, Texans for the Arts.

Dr. Kelley told a story about a young boy who had listened intently over the years to his grandmother telling him stories at bed time. Upon her death the young man was to choose something that was special as a keepsake. He chose the book from which his grandmother had read him the stories. When he later sat to look through it he found that the pages were blank but for this "What was in my heart I have left to you".

Dr. Kelley believes the heart of ministry flows out of ones salvation experience. Thus creating DNA (divine nature affirmed) whereby we engage the world as sons and daughters of the Father and not merely servants. With this and so much more to give Dr. Kelley will have groups of 4-6 athletes go into our high schools this year to administer to the students. School administrators are very excited about this and it is hoped that in 2008 the program will not only mentor to young males but to young women as well.

- The Board of Directors voted to donate \$250 toward the purchase of dining tables and chairs for the new \$30,000 dinning hall at Camp Tonkawa.

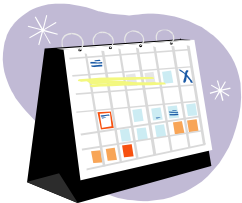
