A CUP OF COLD WATER

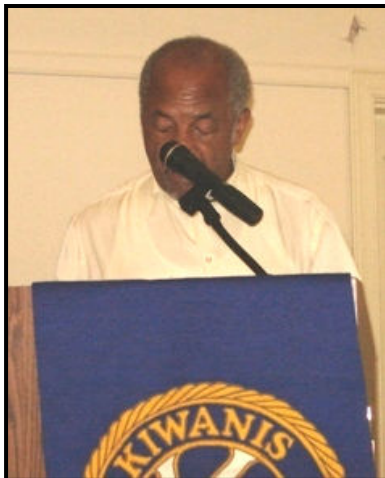
Our program was presented by Gordon Dowell. Gordon shared a Power Point presentation informing us about the project and related topics in Sub-Saharan Africa of which he has just returned. Generally, women have to carry water (muddy polluted water) up to eight kilometers for village use. Contaminated water is the cause of many diseases and illnesses. The well drilling project began in 2005 in southern Zambia with the view of solving this problem for a few villages. It was moved to northwestern Zambia in May of this year. Gordon went to Zambia to help initiate the project at the Mumena Christian Outreach Center. Indeed the mission is to give "a cup of cold (clean) water" to the people who desperately need it.

Over 300,000 meals were served last year. Socks and underwear were given out daily. Last year this Ministry served 30-40 per day and it is currently running 60-80. 65% of the people are poor trying not to be homeless and 35% are homeless. A mobile medical unit and a mobile dental unit go out monthly and are manned by local doctors. The majority of the people are volunteers with only 4 or 5 paid employees.
