James Olson was born in LeMars, Iowa, graduated from the University of Iowa, is a member of the Iowa Bar and attained the rank of Lieutenant Commander in the U.S. Navy. He was a career officer in the directorate of Operations of the Central Intelligence Agency, serving mostly overseas in clandestine operations. Olson has served in the USSR, Austria and Mexico. He speaks French, German, Russian, and Spanish.

With vast experience in international affairs, economics, trade negotiations, intelligence support to the military, counterintelligence, counterterrorism, counter-narcotics, and technical collection systems, James Olson is sure to capture your attention at this meeting.

Author of "The Ten Commandments of Counterintelligence and Fair Play: The Moral Dilemmas of Spying, Olson is now with the George Bush School of government and Public Service at Texas A&M in College Station.
