The 1st report for sales was fantastic! **H.B. Terry** came in first for the GROOVERS, selling **\$1,589.00** in the first week!

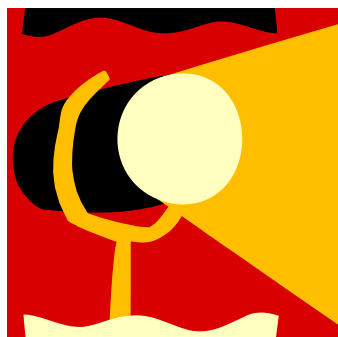
The HIPPIES brought in \$700 this week with **J.C. McCurdy** selling the highest amount for the team at **\$230.00**.
