9. I served in the Army in the European Theater of Operations during World War II.

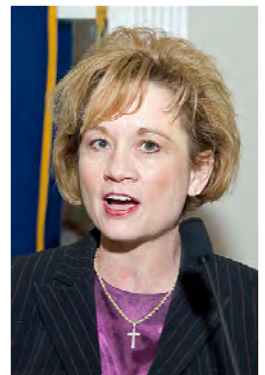
