Dr. Sandy Hazelip and photographer Ellie Hamby will speak to our club this week about their trip through the Middle East. Here is a little information about both of these very interesting travelers.

### **Sandy Hazelip**

Dr. Sandy (as many of her patients call her) is board certified in both Family Practice and Geriatrics. She is the Medical Director for the Senior Healthcare Center in Abilene, Texas, which is a primary care clinic for patients 65 years of age and older. She enjoys the challenges of geriatric patients and feels that the Lord has called her to work with patients who are in the “October, November, and December” of their lives.

She is an author and international lecturer and has spoken in the United States, China, Germany, Croatia, Romania, and Russia on women’s health issues. First and foremost, she is a Christian and enjoys speaking at women’s retreats and ladies’ day programs.

For the past ten years she has had the great pleasure of taking her grandsons on short term mission trips to Zambia, Russia, China, and Cambodia.

### **Ellie Hamby**

Ellie Hamby is a native of Oklahoma and currently serves as a Director of Zambia Medical Mission. This medical mission takes place in the country of Zambia every July and provides medical care in very remote areas to approximately 16,000 Zambians over a two-week period of time.

Ellie lived in Namwianga, Zambia, for 6 years with her husband Kelly, a former ACU professor, and continues to return there several times each year to help

oversee the work of Zambia Mission, which includes schools, a hospital, a radio station and several orphanages.

She has traveled to over 95 countries and is a noted photographer, having produced a number of exhibits. She recently had a featured exhibit of her photography at the Center for Contemporary Arts in Abilene.
