GUITARIST DAN MITCHELL

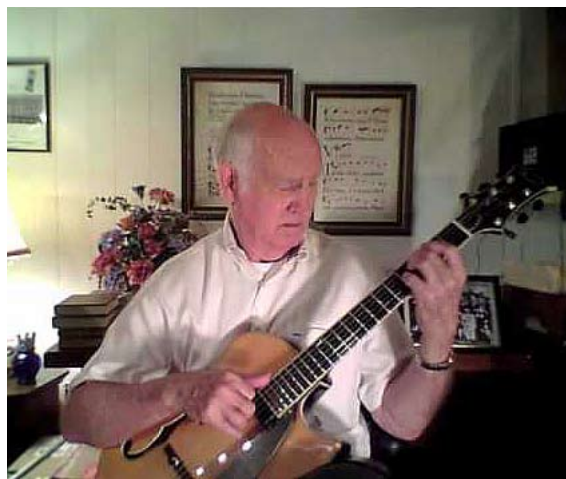
Abilene Country Club, Noon, Wednesday, June 13, 2012

Guitarist extraordinaire Dan Mitchell will perform at our meeting this week.

He is a native Texan, born in 1935 and raised in Ranger, graduating from high school there in 1954.

His college education has been obtained from well-regarded universities such as Rice, North Texas State, East Texas State and Abilene Christian. He holds a bachelor of education degree, and a master's degree in counseling and guidance.

Dan taught at Ranger, Clyde, and Pittsburg in the Texas public school system from 1964-1979, applying his talents to the teaching of biology, and science, as well as coaching football, basketball and track. He is responsible for the implementation of choir programs in both Clyde and Pittsburg.



He then went into business, owning and operating his own music store from 1979-1989.

Dan has been Adjunct Instructor of Guitar at Abilene Christian University and Hardin-Simmons University for 25 years. He has performed in restaurants and for special events for more than two decades, much to the delight of crowds and audiences.

Dan's music has been described as soothing and relaxing, which transports the listener to

wonderfully tranquil places. He has witnessed numerous marriage proposals, providing romantic musical backgrounds to many of them.

In addition, he has been an influence to many budding talents, such as Aaron Watson, affectionately known as the Honky Tonk Kid.
