Mayor Norm Archibald returns to our club to update us on the current water situation in Abilene and what lies in store for us.

Mayor Archibald was elected in May 2004 after serving four years as a City Councilman and reelected in 2005, 2008, and 2011.

A native Texan from San Benito, Texas, he has lived in Abilene for more than 30 years.

In his professional career, Archibald is the Vice President of Abilene's Hendrick Health System. In his position, he is responsible for all of the development of the Health System through the Hendrick Medical Center Foundation.

Archibald holds a B.S. and M.Ed. from Texas A&M University; a M.S. from Abilene Christian University; and a doctorate from Texas Tech University.

Archibald and his wife Nancy have two children and two grandchildren.
