

# SPIRITUAL AIMS THOUGHT TO PONDER

"And the peace of God which transcends all understanding will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus" Phil. 4:7

In our war torn and troubled world, peace seems so elusive. Nations, families and individuals search for it. But our up-side-down world seems ever continuing to pursue it. Peace seems to be one of, if not the, theme of the entire Bible. The Creator is referred to as "The God of Peace". The prophesy of Isa. 9:7 refers to the promised messiah as, among other things, "The Prince of Peace." Peace is frequently spoken of in the N. T.; the salutation to several of the epistles begin with the greeting "Grace and Peace be with you." In Romans 14:17, Paul says "For the kingdom

of God is not a matter of eating and drinking but of righteousness, peace and joy in the Holy Spirit..."

So, how do we acquire "the peace of God which transcends all understanding" as quoted above? The apostle Paul prefaces this by saying, "Rejoice in the Lord always. I will say it again, Rejoice! Let your gentleness be evident to all. The Lord is near. Do not be anxious about anything, but in everything, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God." This is THE HOW!

My conclusion: Only when we experience this kind of peace can we look altruistically, at the needs of others.
